Communion Ministers

Archbishop Coakley requests the names of Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion who are up for their 3-year certification renewal or if you want to become a Minister. Qualifications are: practicing Catholic at least 18yrs old, received Confirmation, member for at least 3yrs, must be in a valid marriage, under no censure and public life must reflect the teachings of the Church. **These qualifications are for those already serving in this ministry as well as for anyone else interested in serving in this ministry: 18 yrs. of age, Confirmed, in a valid marriage, Catholic for 3 yrs., not under censure, reflect teachings of the Church.** If any current Communion Minister needs assistance in fulfilling a qualification, such as being confirmed or having their marriage convalidated, please contact the office. If anyone else among our 3 parishes is interested to start serving as Communion Minister, contact the office by October 22.

IN GOD ALONE

Isaiah speaks to us today of Cyrus, King of Persia, anointed by the Lord. God calls Cyrus by name and leads him in service to the Israelites. In this passage we hear that it is the Lord who gives Cyrus his title, who arms him against his enemies, and who opens doors and unbars gates before him. And God does all of this so that the people will know that “I am the LORD,” and that “there is none besides me” (Isaiah 45:6).

Paul opens his letter with essentially the same notion—that in God alone we find our grace and peace. Paul also gives thanks to God on our behalf, calling to mind our work of faith, hope, and love. And in the familiar Gospel reading, Jesus tells the Pharisees to give to Caesar what is Caesar’s and to God what is God’s.
